# **Entry Requirements**

- Personally experienced a PKP Kinesiology balance.
- Minimum enrolment age 17 years (must be 18 years of age before participating in Supervised Student Clinic).
- Participate in a pre-enrolment interview.
- No minimum education standard is set as a prerequisite for entry to this course.

All prospective students must complete an LLN evaluation assessment (found on the **KSA website**) to ensure they have the skills required to successfully complete the diploma.

- People to practice on (3 clients each week of Term, minimum of 40 clients of various backgrounds)
- A current First Aid certificate (HLTAIDO11). Students must complete their first aid externally.
- **Optional:** Wall Charts for your clinic space, various self-help books including affirmation lists. Ask us about suppliers and resources.

#### For your practitioner self-care:

• One personal kinesiology session with a registered practitioner each Term (at your expense).

# **Eligible for RPL or Credit Transfer?**

If you have completed other qualifications, or have experience, knowledge, and skills acquired through informal learning or previous employment, you may be eligible for recognition of prior learning or credit transfer. <u>More information</u> can be found on the KSA website.

# **Refund Policy**

Students may be entitled to a refund of course fees depending on when the application for withdrawal is received and the circumstances prompting a withdrawal. The student is not entitled to a refund on any course material received prior to the student withdrawing. Students are required to put any request for a refund of course fees in writing.

Where a refund application is received:	Students will receive:
More than 21 days prior to the commencement of course	A refund of the fees paid less a \$395 non-refundable deposit and any home-study or course material received.
Less than 21 days prior to the commencement of course  Additional information on the website	A refund of the fees paid less the non-refundable annual enrolment fee (\$395) and any home-study or course material received. An additional administration fee of \$715 may be charged.

# Withdrawal after commencement of training

Once training has commenced for the course, the scheduled payments match the value of the service and the materials issued, so no refund is available to students who wish to withdraw. If students have received course materials and tuition that exceeds their payments to date, the amount outstanding is payable by the student.

#### **Cancellation of Course**

Should the RTO cancel a course, students are entitled to:

- a refund of fees for the home study units not yet received or workshops not attended.
- transfer of funds to another future course.

In this event, students will be given their preferred option.
